ELECTRICS

It has now been confirmed that CES Electrics have won the Tender to carry out the re-wiring of the church. This is a huge project and it is speculated that works will begin on 13th May, the day after our Patronal festival. The cost of this project will be £87,980+VAT; we have so far £50K and we need to raise the rest of the funds; every way helps, and it would be much appreciated if everyone supports as much as we can, even in the small ways like attending the quiz night for example, or anything else that we put money towards. It cannot be emphasized enough how much we need to raise, even with the very kind donation and loan we have been awarded from the diocese which amounts to £40K.

SECONDARY SCHOOL REQUESTS

In the past few weeks, I have been approached by various families to sign applications for secondary schools. I only sign if the families are known regular attendees of this church which means attending for at least 2x month for at least a year. It is not me being awkward, this is a requirement of any secondary school applicant and so being offered some money towards this church will not benefit the family, as I am in serious breach of depriving another child from a school place if they conform to the school's requirements of obtaining a place in a school. It is very difficult to be offered a choice of a school if one does not conform to the school's policies.
